

LUGGAGE ALLOWANCE

1 Piece Checked Luggage:

62" overall (length+width+height)
50.5 lbs maximum

1 Carryon

Students with instruments/bows—that will be your instrument or bow case

We ask all others to take no carryon unless necessary—so we can avoid resistance from the airlines to getting our instruments on.

For those who need to take a Carryon:
21.5"x15.5"x9" maximum dimensions
17.5 lbs maximum

1 Personal Item, such as a purse or laptop case

11.5x15.5x3.9" maximum dimensions (recommend a backpack)

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Dangerous goods

In order to ensure your safety on board, the transportation of certain items in baggage or hand luggage is prohibited by law.

For safety reasons the following items are not allowed on board (abbreviated):

Samsung Galaxy Note 7 smartphones. The smartphone is neither allowed on board nor in the carry-on and checked baggage.

Briefcases with built-in alarm devices

Pressurized containers containing self-defense sprays

Items that ignite easily, such as matches

Scissors

Pocket knives

FLYING WITH LIQUIDS IS EASY

Which liquids can I take on my flight as hand luggage?

YOU CAN TAKE.....



Liquids, aerosols and gels in containers of 100ml or less packed in a single, transparent, re-sealable 1-litre plastic bag.

3-1-1 Rule: 3 oz containers in 1 1-Quart Bag



Medicines and special dietary products
e.g. baby food



Duty free in a sealed security bag

The items and the receipt must remain sealed inside the security bag provided at the time of purchase.

YOU CANNOT TAKE.....



Please note that all other liquids must be placed in your checked (hold) luggage.

AT THE AIRPORT.....



Please present your liquids separately from other hand luggage for screening at security.



Exceptionally, security may open bottles or containers for screening.

If in doubt ask your airport, airline or retailer in advance of travelling for further information.
