## HOW IS TUITION CALCULATED?

1. Refer to **Table A** for your registration fee. The registration fee is charged once per year per student. Write the fee on Line 1.
2. Refer to **Table B** for the tuition rate, which is based on the length of your lesson and on your teacher. (If your teacher's name is not listed in the table, their rate is the BASE RATE.) Fill in your teacher's rate on Line 2. Multiply Line 2 by 37\* and write the result on Line 3.
3. Refer to **Table C** for class and ensemble fees. If your child is in a string group or orchestra *or both* write in \$145 on Line 4. (If a child participates in both group and orchestra, only one fee is charged.)
4. Write in fees for any other ensembles, theory classes, or Winter Chamber Program on Line 5.
5. Add Lines 1,3,4 and 5. Write the total on Line 6 'Student Total'.
6. Repeat steps 1-5 for each child in your family. Write in your Family Total for all contracts on Line 7.
7. If your family has been awarded a scholarship, refer to your scholarship letter for the amount. Write in the amount (tuition plus group class fees) on Line 8.
8. Subtract Line 8 from Line 7 and write the result on Line 9.
9. Line 9 is your total family tuition for the school year.

\* It is the policy of the Preucil School of Music that enrollment must be made for the entire academic year. Tuition is based on the full academic year of 37 weeks. Occasionally, teachers who have obtained permission from the Director may enroll their students for fewer weeks.

# TUITION CALCULATION WORKSHEET

*This example is for a typical violin student who takes 30 minute lessons and participates in group and orchestra.*

***On Registration Day, the balance due will be \$283.25. There will be seven monthly payments of \$141, due each month October through April.***

To estimate your monthly payment, divide **Line 9** by **9**. To estimate what will be due when you register, multiply the monthly payment by **2**.
