Music Together Placement and Financial Policy

Tuition

\$153.00 per session – Fall, Winter, and Spring. Cost of 6-week Summer session is \$102. Each family pays a registration fee of \$20 once per year. (If a student is taking an instrument lesson and either preschool or Music Together, only the lessons registration fee will be charged. If a student is in both preschool and Music Together, only the preschool registration fee will be charged.) \$76.50 is due at registration, and the balance is due by first day of class. Siblings may join a class for an additional \$80 (\$36 for Summer session with no registration fee for new students). Infants under 4 months are free when attending with a sibling. All classes meet for 45 minutes once a week for 10 weeks each academic session (Fall, Winter and Spring).

Placement Policy

1. Families with children currently enrolled in Music Together are given a preference for enrolling a child in the following session. Those who wish to stay in the same class, day and time receive first priority. Families who wish to switch times, days or classes receive second priority. To maintain this preference, you must pay the tuition and return the signed contract to the office by the date announced at class. After that date, no preference is given.
2. Beginning on the announced Open Registration date, new applicants will be placed in the order they are received. As soon as vacancies are confirmed. You will be contacted to let you know a place is being reserved and advising you to fill out the contract and pay tuition.
3. Open enrollment applicants will be accepted after a specific date. To register, the placement form, contract, and full tuition must be turned in to the office.

Financial Policy

To attend a class, tuition must be PAID IN FULL. Half of the tuition may be paid to hold the spot, with the balance due when the first class begins.

A \$15 finance charge will be added if your account is 30 days overdue.

No refunds will be given once the class has started. Thirty (30) days written notice is required, prior to the first class, for a tuition refund. Ten dollars will be kept to cover administrative costs.
